About Small Faces

Small Faces Child Development Center is a private, non-profit program serving 150 families. The program was established in 1970 and has been housed in its present location at the Crown Hill School since 1980. We



believe that each child should feel secure and cared for by people he/she can trust. Our staff plan rich, varied, culturally diverse activities in a safe, healthy environment.

We accept contracts with DSHS and DHS for subsidized care based on income. Our fees include meals, snacks and bus tickets for field trips. A nominal activity fee may be requested for special events, such as swim lessons.

Big Kids (2nd-5th graders)

Big Kids provides the creative, physical and exploratory experiences children use to create their own unforgettable summer.

We spend as much time outside as possible, whether exploring the city through weekly field trips and park days or playing group sports and games in our own backyard.



At the center, the Big Kids' room is set up with multiple activity centers designed to encourage self-directed play and discovery. The woodworking area is stocked with tools and equipment for carpentry. We have a well stocked art area and a stage for dramatic play. Our Technology Center gives children the opportunity to record their own music and make DVDs of their own skits and plays. We have a cooking area and a summer economy funded by the BK Bank.

Middle Kids (K-1st grade)

The Middle Kids' program includes a wide range of activities including: science, athletics, reading, journal writing, fine arts, organic gardening, and dramatic play.



Throughout our day, we balance active time with quiet time. Our activities will help us grow physically, cognitively and socially

In our teaching, we focus on the child's "process" rather than "product." Therefore, our activities are "open-ended," (without concept of right or wrong).

We go on many adventures throughout the city, visiting various parks, weekly field trips, neighborhood walks, picnics and weekly swimming at the Ballard Pool.
